Free State Region July Meeting Report

Good morning, all,

I attended the hybrid Off-Month Regional meeting on July 9, 2022. Six (6) areas were in attendance.

The following points were discussed in the meeting.

1) Service Center- Ellen

The report was presented by the new Vice-President, Ellen.

- a) The sales were flat this month at the Service Center.
- b) The Commemorative White Book is still on sale. As a reminder, the cost is \$25.
- c) The Service Center is accepting donations. (**Note:** for those interested, you can do it in-person, or in-line via the freestate web page. The link is: <https://www.fsrsc.com/donate.html> . Alternatively you can also Cash App to \$FRSCNA or Venmo @Frank-Dyson).
- d) The treasurer report was sent to Secretary.

2) Free State- Wayne

- a) Introduced three new members for the Convention in keeping with the goals of having an adequate representation from all areas and demographics of the Region.
 - a. Shelly P from Baltimore
 - b. Cynthia S from NE Freedom
 - c. Bonnie A from Westside.
- b) The Convention is getting ready to start selling Registration in the next few weeks. The costs for pre-registration will stay as it was last year: \$ 10.00 for addict with a clean time < 3years; \$20.00 for clean time > years. This is a substantial decrease from 3 years go namely 60% decrease for <3 years clean time, and 33% decrease for >3years clean time.

- c) The package this year will include five meals, Friday night, Saturday morning breakfast, Saturday lunch, Saturday dinner, Sunday brunch; basically, a meal at each plenary meeting. The cost will be \$ 30.00 each meal. The cost of the full package will be \$170.00. Buying the full package will come with a decrease in Registration fee to \$20.00

3) Chair: Stepped down for Health reasons

4) Vice-Chair-Larry: presented a thank you note to the Region for continue collaboration

5) RD- Chris:

- AZF Meeting scheduled at Greater Philadelphia on July 30, 2022.
- AZF: Chris presented his budget to attend the AZF meeting
- NAWS financial update:
 - i. Operating expenses are in the red
 - ii. Contributions exceeded 60%
 - iii. However, sales are slowly starting to return to Pre-Covid levels
 - iv. Expenses are 20% below budget
 - v. Plan to continue working on Inventory
 - vi. Legal costs have increased due to some pending lawsuits worldwide:
 - 1. One in the Philippines regarding fellowship trust
 - 2. The World did prevail in the lawsuit in California
 - 3. Personal injury lawsuit form WCNA 27 at Orlando.
 - 4. Total costs of all these lawsuits are greatly impacting the budget
(Overwhelmingly from California case)
 - vii. Iran is trying to separate from NAWS
 - viii. Financial Reserve did allow NAWS to survive during pandemic.
 - ix. A statement of financial aspect is posted at the world site including both physical assets and cash
 - x. Financial liabilities:
 - xi. Waiting for PP2 loan
 - xii. Every year audits are required for physical inventory. Over 2 million items are to be accounted for. This is a time-consuming activity.
 - xiii. WSC Travels Reports are posted at NA world services

6) RDA- John:

- June 18 Webinar discussed two (2) topics:
 - i. The future or WSC Conference:
 1. Three (3) years Conference cycle to be tested
 2. Procedures for Delegated funding: available only upon request. Will no longer be automatic. Funding for RDAs not included.
 3. There is a meeting today on Fellowship development. The topic is to explore new ideas for Fellowship development
- The NAWS is currently revising the Loner IP (IP # 21). Accepting input online at: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/theloner>
- SPAD book, like the Just for Today, is available for daily distribution online. The link to register for free subscription to this book and all others is: <https://www.na.org/?ID=subscribe>
- There are a few current Surveys online
 - Ongoing DRT/MAT (*Medication-Assisted Treatment*). The link for that survey is: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/drtmat>
 - CP Webinar: (More Info to come)
 - Discussions at the WSC regarding 3 years cycles. There will be a trial of 2 consecutive Cycles to see how it goes. As a side note, the Consensus at the Free State Regions was to keep it at 2 years cycles.
- Because of the changes to the WSC Conference cycles, the commitment time for the next RD will be at one year in order to adjust the position to WSC cycles.
- We need at the Regions to discuss on how to synchronize the two years requirements at the Region to the three years WSC cycles. More likely there will be a need for one year leap time, and then move on to three years term.

7) Secretary and Alternate Secretary: Both reports were posted at the website.

8) Policy Facilitator- Joe: Currently trying to locate at the Service Center with Franck's help an area to store the Archives.

9) Treasurer- April:

- a. Total Donation for the month: \$2,444.07
- b. Total Expenses: \$2,44.07; which include \$1,442.02 sent to the World. (Report is attached).

10) Old Business:

a. Nominations

- i. Michelle H for Treasurer. Nominated by April
- ii. Wayne W is nominated for Web-Servant
- iii. Randy B for alternate Secretary. She is the current RCM for Bay area. Nominated by Shelby.

b. Forty (40) years Speaker Jam Celebration project is currently on hold.

c. Consensus Based Decision Making was again discussed. It was noted since there is no current written policy to keep Robert Rules of Order as deliberative medium, we can, at the Region, continue experimenting with the consensus decision making process.

How will it proceed?

- i. A proposal can only be made by RCM unless it affects the Executive Body (for e. the Treasurer).
- ii. Discussions will be open to anybody in attendance, but only RCM can vote.
- iii. The threshold for passing a proposal is still to be determined: 75%, versus 80%?
- iv. We need to discuss also whether it needs to be written in the minutes.
- v. The timeline for adoption will be to fine-tune until September, and then vote in October. However, the policy facilitator cautions anything that we are going to implement can't be until the policy change is written.
- vi. Quorum for a session will be 50% + 1 for a minimum of six (6) areas.
- vii. The Chair will serve as facilitator for deliberations.

Meeting was adjourned.

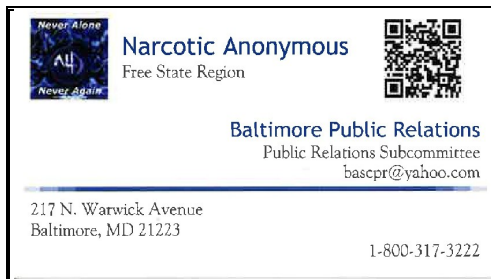

BASC Public Relations Subcommittee Report

August 6, 2022

Good afternoon, Baltimore Area Service,
Executive Committee Members, and
Group Service Representatives (GSRs) –

- ❖ PR and the NA member – *Why is this important to me? – From the Baltimore Area PR Outline:*
 - **Public Relations** –refers to all of the relationships we create and maintain with the general public, professionals, potential members, and each other in our groups and service communities.
 - This implies an ongoing relationship, based on the many opportunities we have to build and sustain ongoing relations with the public. The example of our members play a tremendous role in building relationships with the public ...
 - *“The actions we take in forming relationships with the public can have a profound effect on whether or not addicts can find NA.”*

The July 2022 Public Relations Subcommittee meeting was held on Monday, July 25. This was a virtual meeting. The meeting opened and closed with the “We” version of the Serenity Prayer. Regular Subcommittee meetings are held on the 4th Monday of each month on Zoom at 6 pm. (I joined the FSRNA PR Subcommittee meeting on Monday, Aug. 1. FSRNA PR meets virtually on Zoom on the 1st Monday of each month.)

1. Area Meeting List - Check up/ reclamation effort. We continued discussing the Area Meeting List Check up and reclamation effort. The focus is to reach out to groups that are not registered with Area, to find out what their needs are and how we can help: If you know of meeting in the schedule that is not actually meeting, let us know. All suggestions are welcome. One late entry in the ideas column is requesting “Help” from members attending the Area Convention in August, placing an enlarged copy of the old schedule on a table for members to review and update using the Service Center meeting update form.

2. Home Group Assistance. On Friday, July 22nd the Subcommittee held a special meeting at the request of the Cherry Hill Listen to Learn Group, and offered the group input and suggestions on drafting a letter seeking to resume its meeting space. We also provided a draft use of space agreement for the group to use, if they wished to have a written agreement regarding monthly donations and reciprocal expectations for the group and the facility.

3. Tuerk Conference (Thursday, Sep. 15, 2022) – The FSRNA PR Subcommittee Chair is in process registering for five members to attend/participate. The event is scheduled from 9 am – 5 pm, and we currently have one full-time attendee and two part-time attendees planning to participate.

4. Learning Day/Workshop. We’re still planning Learning Days with H&I. The space needs to be handicap accessible locations, could be either in the West or East.
