- 1. To fulfill our fellowship's primary purpose, the NA groups have joined together to create a structure which develops, coordinates, and maintains services on behalf of NA as a whole.**
- 2. The final responsibility and authority for NA services rests with the NA groups.**
- 3. The NA groups delegate to the service structure the authority necessary to fulfill the responsibilities assigned to it.**
- 4. Effective leadership is highly valued in Narcotics Anonymous. Leadership qualities should be carefully considered when selecting trusted servants.**
- 5. For each responsibility assigned to the service structure, a single point of decision and accountability should be clearly defined.**
- 6. Group conscience is the spiritual means by which we invite a loving God to influence our decisions.**
- 7. All members of a service body bear substantial responsibility for that body's decisions and should be allowed to fully participate in its decision-making processes.**
- 8. Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications.**

- 9. All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all viewpoints in their decision-making processes.**
- 10. Any member of a service body can petition that body for the redress of a personal grievance, without fear of reprisal.**
- 11. NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly.**
- 12. In keeping with the spiritual nature of Narcotics Anonymous, our structure should always be one of service, never of government.**

**Free State Region September Meeting Report**

Good morning, all,

I attended the virtual Off-Month Regional meeting on September 10, 2022. Seven (7) areas were present at the beginning, then eight (8).

The following points were discussed.

**1) Service Center- Franck**

- The landlord is working on securing the walls of the building. Hopefully this will be fixed and we will be able to meet in persons again at the Region starting next month. The front door has also been replaced.
- NAWS announced because of supply chain issues, they are going short in merchandises such as key tags. Franck made sure to stock an adequate amount to starve off the shortage.
- A reminder. Coming January 1, 2023, there will be a 12% price increase in bronze medallions, and books.
- NAWS has printed additional white books. The Service Center did place an order for over 100 books. Those interested should order as soon as possible since they are selling very fast.
- Finally, Franck announced literature sales are moving in the right direction; \$27,600 of sales last month.

**2) Free State- Wayne**

- a) Wayne introduced a new board member, Rachel M filling a vacancy.
- b) Registration: As of the meeting date there was a total of 716 Pre-Registration sold. The target is around 900-950. **Please note there was an error in last month report. We erroneously reported the ceiling for Pre-Registrations was 700.** Since total

number of participants at the Convention should be at 1,500, this will leave around 500-600 registrations available for walk-in.

- c) There is about an equal number of pre-registrations sold to addicts <3years and >3years.
- d) Wayne also announced a total of \$23,000 in meals have been sold. This is a 125% excess of the value of \$15,000 mandated in the contract with the hotel. As a result, others fees such as meeting rooms costs will be waived or reduced.
- e) The main speakers are being chosen. For the Friday night opening meeting in keeping with tradition, there will be two speakers from our Region: Randy J with over 41 years of clean time and Karen with over 40 years. Saturday night main speaker will be Ritchie from New York and Sunday morning speaker will be Sherman from DC.
- f) Included in the Merchandises, there will be sculpted soaps sold this year
- g) The Convention price for hotel room is \$109.00 per night plus tax.

**3) Treasurer: Michelle**

- The total amount of donations is \$3,775.39. Expenses are \$4,173.11. Beginning account balance was 12,218.58. Adding beginning balance and income for this month and minus this month expenses, the total cash available was \$11,820.86. Subtracting the earmarked, and reserves (Regional and RDs) from that sum, the balance available to be sent to the world is \$3,762.86.
- The treasurer submitted a motion for a one- time waiver of the prohibition to conduct new business in off-month. The motion passed 7 for, 1 against.
- Treasurer then made another motion to hold the money to be sent to the world this month, since she is new in that position and doesn't know if everything will be settled. The motion passed 5 in favor, 3 against. For the record, we, at the Baltimore area we voted No because of the violation of established principle.
- Finally, the treasurer made a last motion to spend \$20.00 to buy a treasurer box. The motion passed unanimously

**4) RD: John**

- The motion regarding retiring H&I handbook made by our Region to be included in the incoming CAR Report was accepted. It was delayed from last CAR report because of COVID.

**5) Chair: Larry**

The Chair stressed out the dire state at the Region due to the high amount of vacancies. All businesses will be paralyzed other than the Convention, Service Center, Treasurer, until some crucial vacancies such as Secretary and Policy Facilitator are filled. He also pointed only one sub-committee has been filled. There was a brainstorming among all participants to discuss the best approach to address this crisis. Some ideas proposed was for all RCMs to relay the informations to areas emphasizing the dire needs for support; to tap into networks of sponsors/sponsees for recruitment; call to old timers; reaching out to Freestate Convention board members, etc. The general agreement was this needs to be a group effort.

Meeting was adjourned.

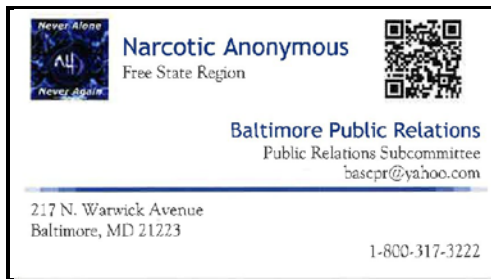

## BASC Public Relations Subcommittee Report

Executive Committee Members, and  
Group Service Representatives (GSRs) –

❖ PR Basics –

- The foundational principal of all our service efforts is the group’s primary purpose – The Fifth Tradition: “Each group has but one primary purpose – to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.
- We approach our service with an attitude of humility: We are simply recovering addicts trying to carry a message of recovery—one that someone else freely shared with us—to other suffering addicts.
- NA is a not-for-profit organization. In accordance with our Seventh Tradition—we are fully self-supporting through our own contributions. As the public gains more knowledge about NA, they become more inclined to offer their support by referring clients, family and friends to the NA program. This type of support builds relationships with the public founded on trust and goodwill.

\*\*\*

The September 2022 Public Relations Subcommittee meeting was held on Monday, Sept. 26. This was a virtual meeting. The meeting opened and closed with the “We” version of the Serenity Prayer. Regular Subcommittee meetings are held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month on Zoom at 6 pm.

1. Tuerk Conference (Thursday, Sep. 15, 2022: 9 am – 4 pm) – We hosted a PR table with NEFA at the 2022 Tuerk Conference. Registration was paid for by FSRNA. Three members from Baltimore PR participated, and two members participated from NEFA.

2. New Meeting Requests:

- We’re waiting on group representatives to schedule a meeting with PR and church representatives.
- As yet, the group hasn’t decided on a name

- The church representative hasn’t gotten back with the group representatives with the go ahead for the meeting.

3. Area Meeting List - Check up/ reclamation effort. PR has created a spreadsheet listing the “missing” meeting, by day and time, in the Baltimore Areas. “Missing” refers to meetings that were listed in the 2020 FSRNA schedule but are not listed in the current FSRNA/BASC BMLT schedule. A rough count shows over 200 meetings that were listed in the Jan. 2020 FSRNA schedule that are unaccounted for in the current schedule.

- Members of the Policy Subcommittee attended the Sep. 26 PR Subcommittee meeting and volunteered to take on the search/reclamation effort for the Sunday and Tuesday list.
- The BASC Chair (Mario) volunteered to work on the Monday list.
- PR Subcommittee members (and other volunteers) are needed for the Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday lists.
- An example of the spreadsheet (for Saturday) is attached.

4. Learning Day/Workshop. PR and H&I are planning a joint Learning Day for possibly Sat. Dec. 17<sup>th</sup> from 12 – 3 pm at the Forest Park Senior Center, or another location to be determined. We’re hoping this can be a hybrid event that can be recorded for future reference by both PR and H&I.

5. Bus Signage. We reached out to NEFA to find out whether they are interested in collaborating with the bus signage project this year. Last year signs were placed at four bus stops in the Baltimore and Northeast Freedom areas at a price of \$1,175 that was split three ways (between Baltimore, NEFA and FSRNA).

FSRNA/BASC BMLT Schedule*

Attached is an Excel and pdf spreadsheet listing by day and time the Baltimore Area meetings from the FSRNA 2020 meeting list that are missing from the current schedule. You can use the Jan. 2022 "marked" schedule for the address/location of where these meetings were held in 2020. The spreadsheet is by day, which allows you to print out separate sheets (by day and time) to check on whether the meeting is still in existence, abandoned or changed its meeting time and place. Beneath the "missing" meetings, there's a format for "new" meetings (by day and time), for any new meetings that need to be added to the schedule.

I think the spreadsheet will make this a little easier -- to call someone, who knows someone, who knows someone who knows something about many of the missing meetings. Feel free to take apart the spreadsheet by day or time, or anyway that works best for you. **If we find the contact person(s) for the missing groups, we should ask those persons to confirm the status of the meeting** (open, closed, changed location. changed from in-person to virtual or other) and if the meeting still exists but is not listed in the schedule, the Group Contact Person should be asked to submit a "Meeting Update Form" to the Webservant.
